- *Public comments due **by Oct 31.***

- *Plan Bay Area is a long-range integrated transportation and land-use/housing strategy through 2040 for the San Francisco Bay*
- *On July 18, 2013, the Plan was jointly approved by the Association of Bay Area Governments Executive Board and by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission.*
