


Micromobility Overview

Key Deliverables

- 1. Evaluate the feasibility of a micromobility program
- Define program benefits, establish County specific goals and performance measures
- Perform case studies research, and summarize findings and recommendations
- 4. Assess market demand and identify potential pilot locations
- Develop program guidelines and sample micromobility permit application, and draft ordinance template with fee examples
