Bunker Hill Drive and Avenue Alhambra Safe Routes to School Pedestrian Improvements Project (HSIP Grant)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Project consists of a midblock crosswalk with curb extensions and standard accessible curb ramps to increase visibility and shorten crossing distances, provides an improved crossing for pedestrians and serves as a traffic calming feature to slow traffic.





CURRENT PHASE: CONSTRUCTION

All concrete and flatwork will be completed by Nov. 2023.






2023 Pavement Preservation Project

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The 2023 Pavement Preservation Project includes pavement repairs, micro surfacing, slurry seal, restriping of pavement markings, and bicycle striping improvements of 15.5 miles of various streets in the unincorporated areas of San Mateo County.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:




