

## San Mateo County Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) 2024 Work Plan

**Mission Statement:** *The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee advises the Board of Supervisors on funding, projects, programs, and policies related to improving and increasing bicycling and walking transportation.*

**Committee Meetings:** Meetings of the BPAC are held regularly on the third Thursday of the even numbered months. The 2024 schedule is as follows: February 15, April 18, June 20, August 15, October 17, and December 18.
