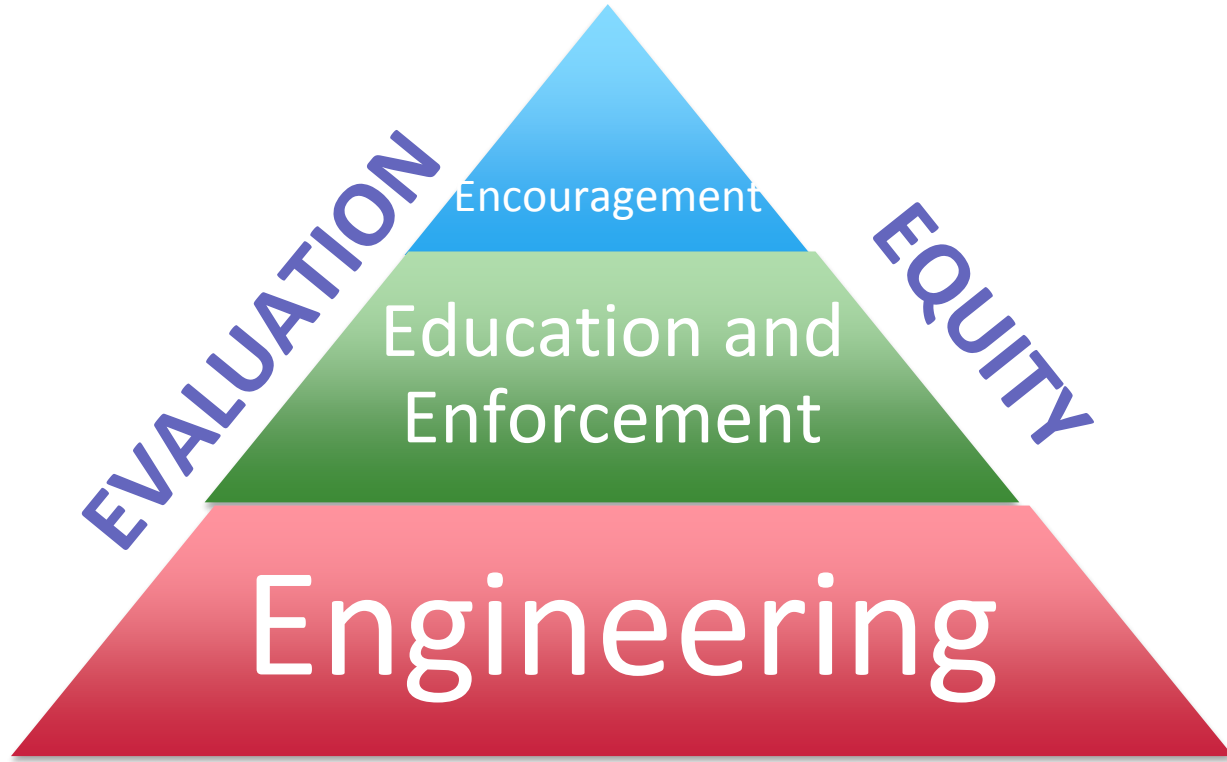

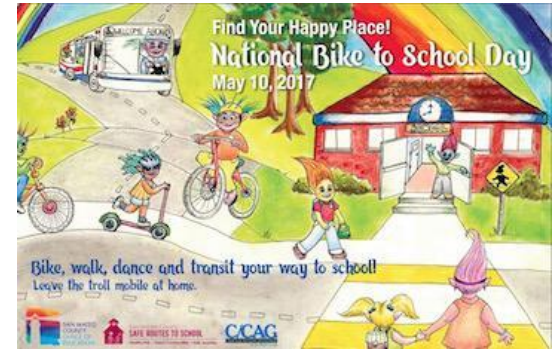

2016-2017: 3,980 – **108% increase!**

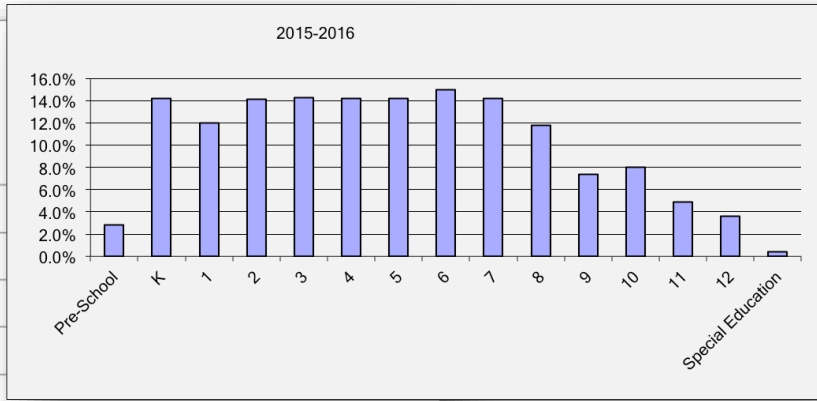
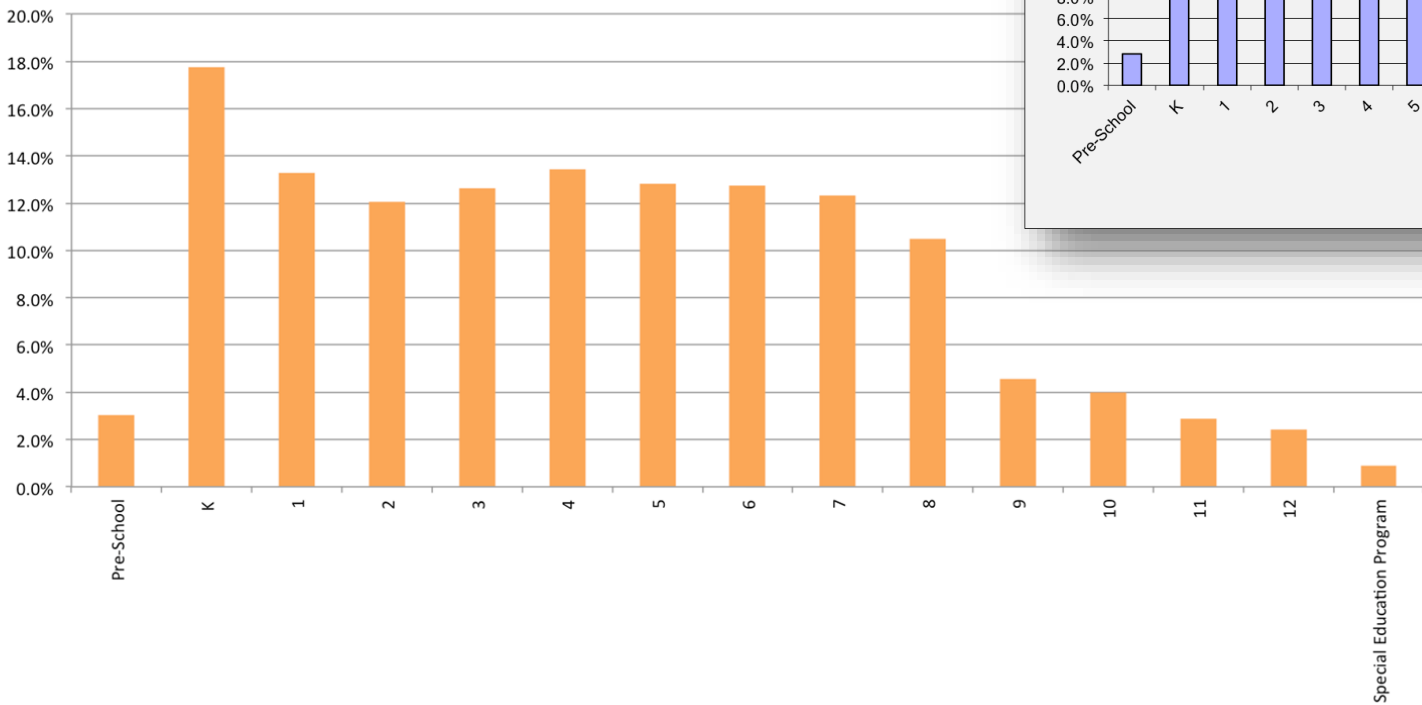

* 338% increase in Spanish survey takers from 15-16

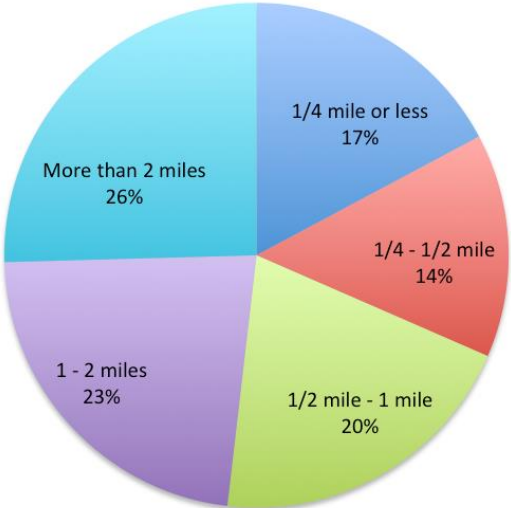

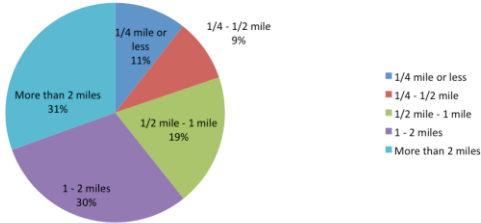


What is the approximate distance from your home to the school?

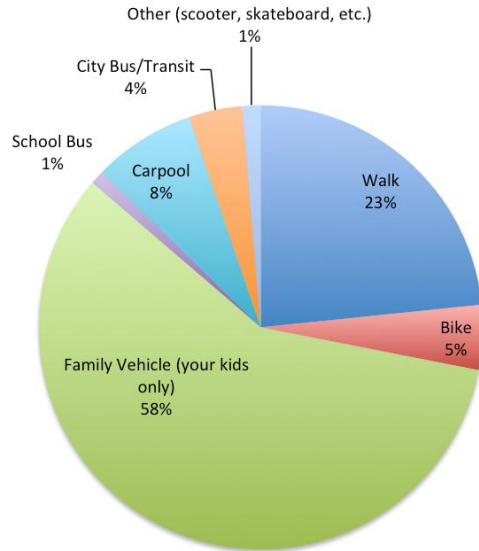

- More than 2 miles

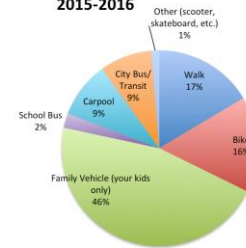
How does your child USUALLY travel to school?

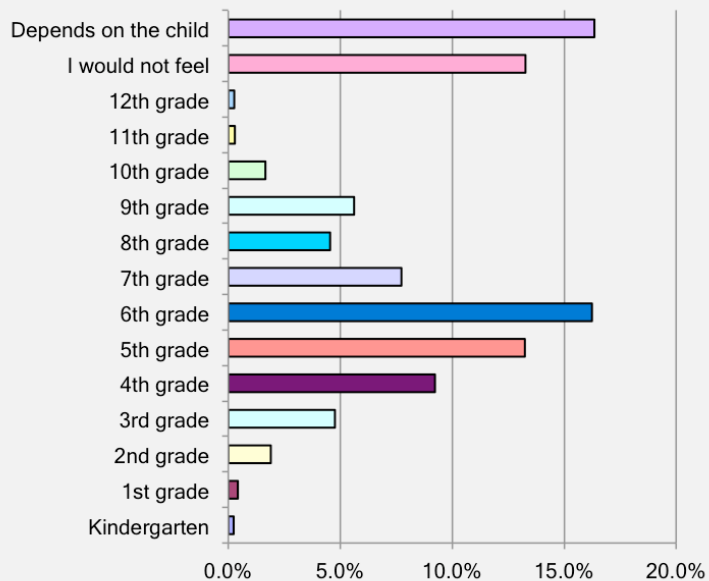

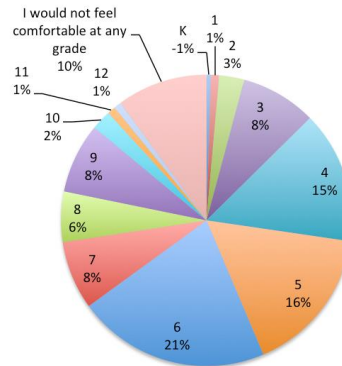


At what grade level would you allow your child/children to WALK to/from school without an adult?

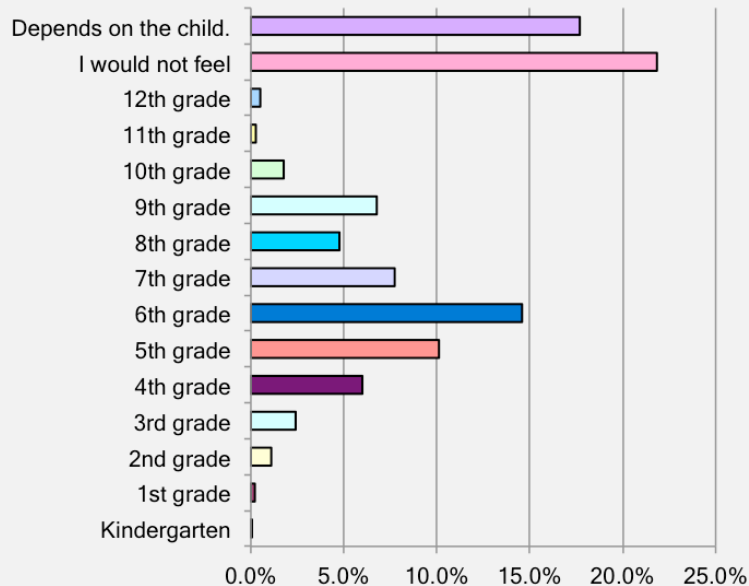

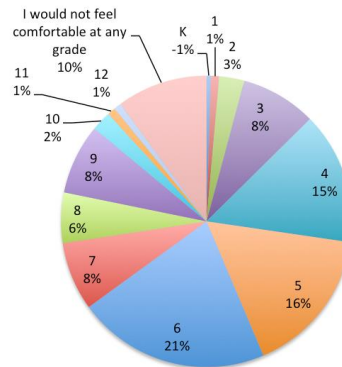


At what grade level would you allow your child/children to BIKE to/from school without an adult?

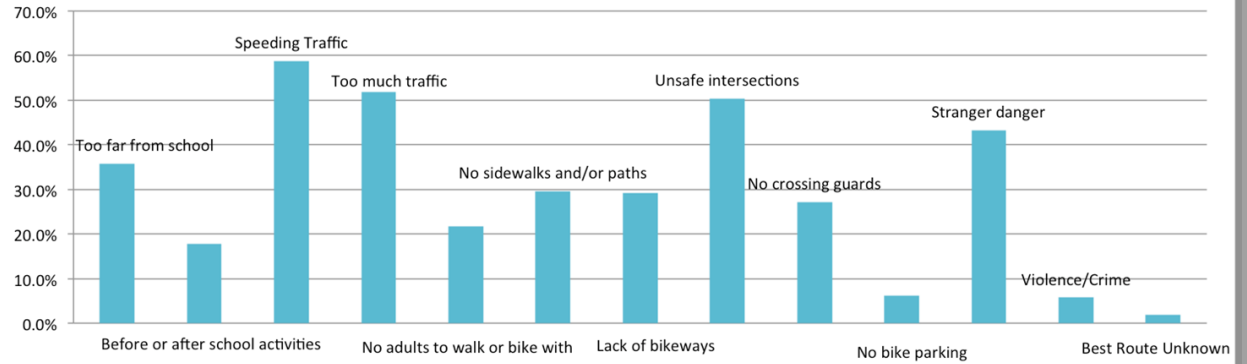

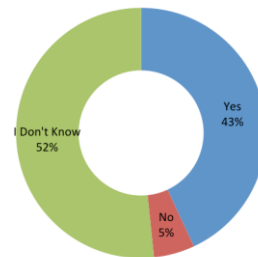


Does your child/children's school have a Safe Routes to School (SRTS) program?

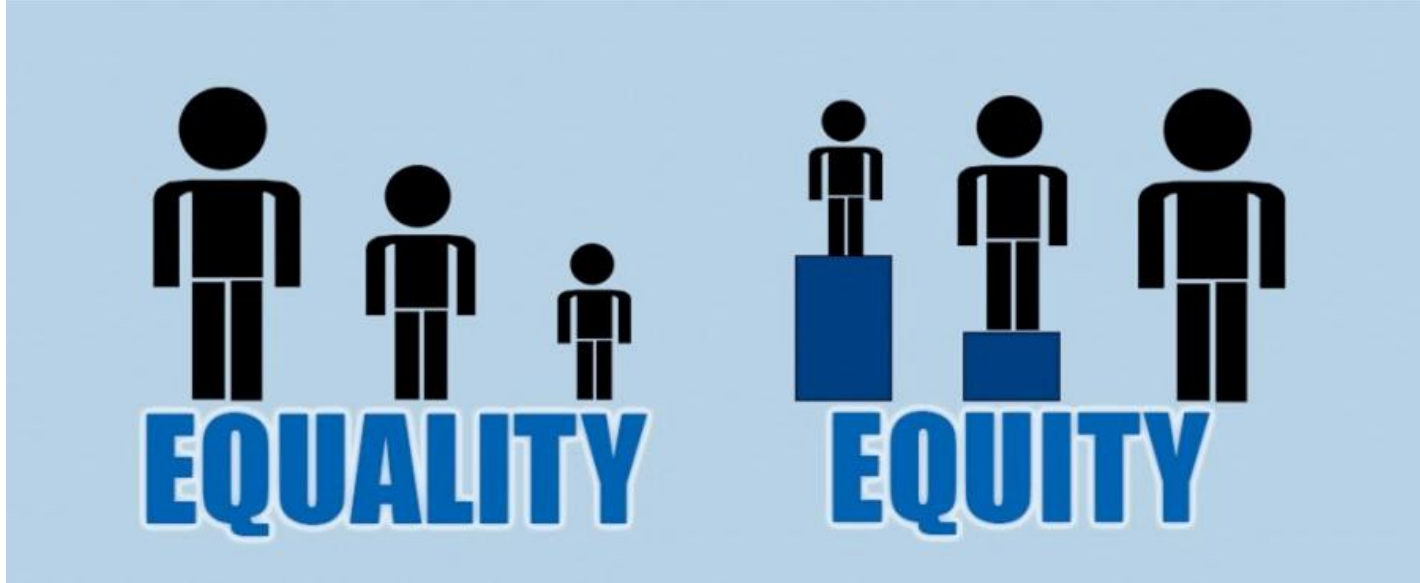

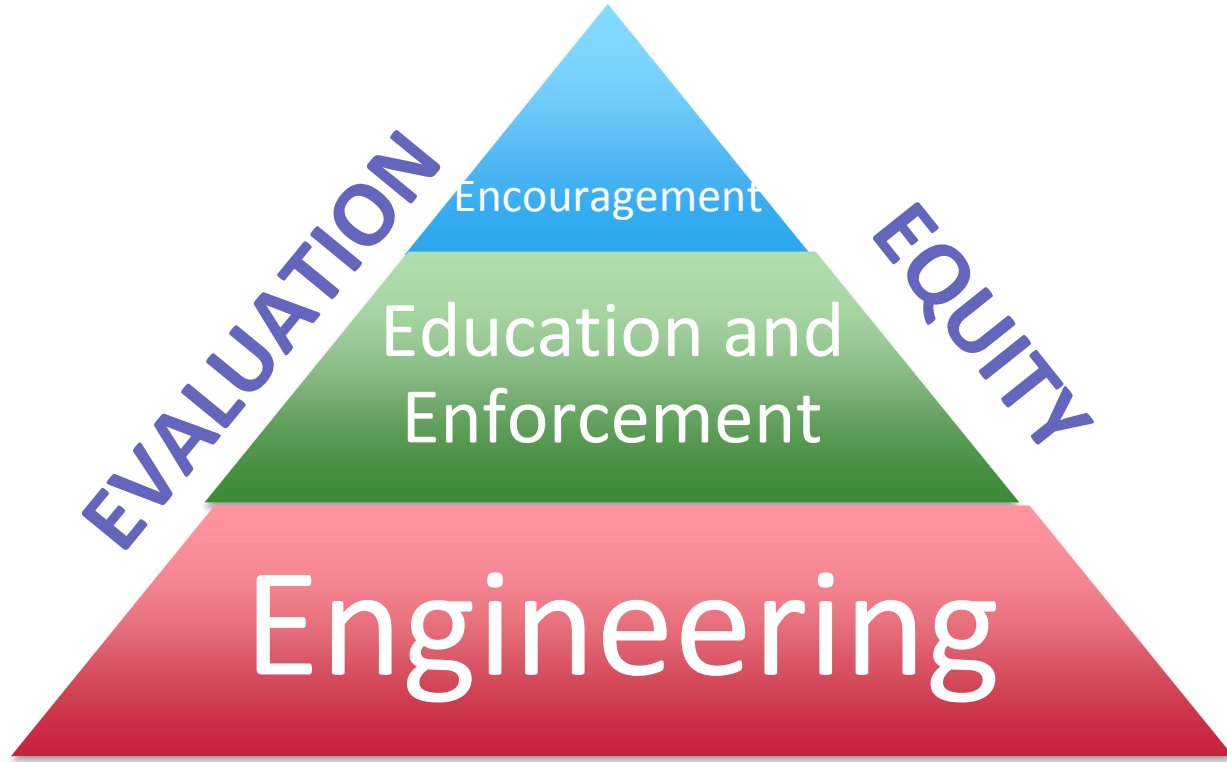
